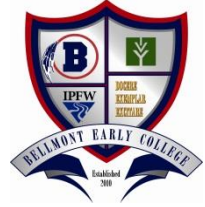




Bellmont Early College High School



Student Admissions Process 2019-2020

Students wishing to enroll in the Belmont Early College High School Cohort Program must submit a completed application to Belmont High School, Attn: Michelle Blackburn by no later than **Friday, April 12, 2019**.

Bellmont Early College High School is open to all incoming freshmen.

Priority may be given to:

- 21st Century Scholars
- Students on free/reduced lunch status
- Minority students
- First Generation College Student

To apply, you must:

- a. Complete the application form (fill out *all areas* of the application)
- b. **Attach a recent photo to this application**
- c. Have a good attendance and behavior record
- d. Have demonstrated a strong work ethic

Bellmont Early College Committee will obtain:

- a. A copy of your Middle School Transcript or most recent grade card
 - b. A copy of your most recent ISTEP/NWEA test scores.
 - c. A copy of your most recent IEP or 504 plan, if applicable.
- * if you are applying from out of state, please include your standardized test scores in your application

Once all materials are collected by the April 12th deadline, the Belmont Early College Committee will then do a complete administrative review of all materials.

STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

To be in BEC, you will need to adhere to the following expectations:

- I will make education a high priority in my life, including positive participation in class and school activities.
 - No missing assignments
 - I will compete in Croner Cup Challenges with my SRT teammates
 - If I am unable to attend my SRT because of another commitment, I will check in with my advisor as soon as possible
 - I will not question BEC activities (ex. “What if I don’t participate?”)
 - Not turning in permission forms by the due dates is not acceptable

- I will be prepared to spend the necessary time each night on homework, studying, and reading.
 - Commitments outside of academics are not an excuse
 - Failure to communicate with teachers will not be an excuse (ex. Not checking in with a teacher after an absence)

- I understand that I need to maintain at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA
 - In order to be eligible for college credit courses, this is a minimum expectation

- I will maintain good behavior
 - I will show respect for everyone in the school community and the rights of others to learn and succeed – I will not be a distraction
 - Violations of Bellmont High School’s policies that result in RISQ or Out of School Suspension may also result in removal from the BEC program
 - Any classroom issues or office referrals may be grounds for review by the BEC committee

- I understand that I will be required to attend study tables 1.5 hours per week if I earn 2 or more C’s, or a D/F on any grade report.
 - It is my responsibility to communicate this to my parents, coaches, employer or any other individual who needs to be aware of this commitment
 - I understand that I am required to attend study tables until my SRT advisor specifically informs me otherwise
 - It is my responsibility to get the required signatures to show that I completed study tables weekly and communicate this to my SRT advisor
 - It is my responsibility to be aware of my grades through Powerschool
 - The first incident of non-compliance will result in a meeting with the BEC committee and a warning/reminder. The second incident will result in removal from the BEC Program

- I will be punctual and maintain good attendance (95% or higher).
 - This is Bellmont High School’s basic attendance policy – college course attendance may be more strict

- I will act in an honest and responsible manner in all my activities as a Bellmont Early College student. I will not participate in violations of academic integrity, including plagiarism, cheating, or fabricating information.

 - My student may be removed from the BEC program for any violation of Belmont High School's policies that result in RISQ/out of school suspension.
 - Any classroom issues or office referrals by my student may be grounds for review by the BEC committee
- I understand my student needs to maintain at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA.
 - I understand that in order to be eligible for college credit courses, there is a minimum expectation
- I understand that my student will be required to attend after school study tables at 1.5 hours per week if he/she should earn 2 or more C's and/or 1 D or 1 F on a grade report.
 - The first incident of non-compliance will result in a meeting with the BEC committee and a warning/reminder. The second incident will result in removal from the BEC Program
